### Legal definition of borders

- Declaration of State Sovereignty of Ukraine (16.07.1990)
  - Article 5 "Territorial Supremacy": "The territory of the Ukrainian SSR within its existing boundaries is inviolable and cannot be changed or used without its consent"
- Law on the Succession of Ukraine (12.08.1991)
  - Article 5: "the state border of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics (...) as of 15 July 1990 was the state border of Ukraine"
- The Act of Declaration of Independence of Ukraine (24.08.1991)
  - "The territory of Ukraine as indivisible and inviolable"

### International recognition of borders

- 1. Delimitation
- 2. Signing of a bilateral treaty
- 3. Ratification by both parliaments
- 4. Preservation by the UN Secretary General









### Leonid Osovalyuk

"Here is an example from the early 2000s. Sumy Oblast borders with Bryansk Oblast. Farming and vegetable growing are developed in the border area of Sumy region, while in Bryansk region there are abandoned lands. The chairmen informally agreed: I will send cattle to your plot to graze, OK? The next summer there were already farms there... This is a real case when a whole Ukrainian cattle-breeding complex ended up on Russian territory. Houses for service personnel were being built nearby. But when the working groups agreed where to draw the border, the Russians lifted the archives. Overnight, they took away hundreds of cattle and tractors from the peasants and expelled the Ukrainian staff. And we were forced to admit: yes, a violation, we are starting over."





### Vladimir Putin, 21 February 2022

"This process started practically right after the 1917 revolution, and Lenin and his associates did it in a way that was extremely harsh on Russia – by separating, severing what is **historically Russian land**. Nobody asked the millions of people living there what they thought.

Then, both before and after the Great Patriotic War, Stalin incorporated in the USSR and transferred to Ukraine some lands that previously belonged to Poland, Romania and Hungary. In the process, he gave Poland part of what was traditionally German land as compensation, and in 1954, Khrushchev took Crimea away from Russia for some reason and also gave it to Ukraine. In effect, this is how the territory of modern Ukraine was formed."
