Call for Applications — Poster Presentation MA and PhD Projects

On the occasion of the third anniversary of the initiative *Ukrainian Research in Switzerland,* the international conference *Ukrainian Studies Today. State of the Art in Switzerland* will be held at the University of Basel from 29 to 31 January 2020. The conference will be attended by all of the URIS fellows from the years 2017–2020, the members of the URIS academic advisory board, and numerous Ukraine experts from Switzerland and abroad.

We are inviting students and doctoral candidates at Swiss universities to present their current Ukrainerelated MA theses and doctoral projects at the conference in poster form. The conference offers a unique opportunity to present your research project to an experienced and knowledgeable international audience and discuss unresolved questions with them. The project posters will be displayed in the foyer of the conference venue and presented by the authors in short 5-10 minute presentations.

A total of **eight places** are available for the two scheduled poster sessions. URIS is organising the printing and production of the posters and covering the travel, accommodation and food expenses of the students / doctoral candidates taking part in the poster presentation.

Eligibility requirements:

- Current Ukraine-related research project at a Swiss university (MA thesis or PhD project)
- Poster in English with an attractive design (text and illustrations/graphics)
 - Format A 0 (approx. 900 x 1250 mm)
 - o Max. number of characters text (incl. spaces): 1'500
 - Max. number of illustrations/photos: 3
 - o Minimum resolution for image files: 300 dpi
 - Your university logo
- Deadline for submission of text and image files (.doc / .jpg): 17 January 2020
