Our Online Colloquium will consist of a weekly talk given by a doctoral student and/or early-stage researcher from German universities and abroad. Due to the restrictions on teaching at universities, all events will take place online, which should enable more people, regardless of their geographic location, to actively and passively participate. An extended Q&A session is planned to take place after the talk.

By inviting speakers from a range of disciplines within the humanities and social sciences, this online format aims at providing a platform for an interdisciplinary exchange of ideas and a place of encounter of students and researchers interested in and focusing on Ukrainian studies. Speakers are strongly encouraged to not only present their own research topics, but also to actively engage in the discussion with other participants too and provide feedback for their colleagues. In addition, contact with one of the professors in the field shall be established in advance for the purpose of having a supervision in the process of preparation as well as during the lecture itself, and to be provided with a constructive feedback after the talk.

Our Colloquium aims at connecting scholars of Ukrainian and East European Studies at the European University Viadrina as well as other institutions in the Berlin and Brandenburg area to colleagues in and outside Ukraine and the neighbouring countries. Our Colloquium shall thus help to strengthen ties with scholars and scientific partner institutions abroad. It should not only be regarded as a place of networking for researchers in the field, but also as an opportunity to enhance cooperation between individuals and relevant institutions.

Our online colloquium will be open to anyone interested and is going to be held in English.

All talks, after an approval by the speaker, will be recorded and made available online at the [‘Entangled History of Ukraine’ YouTube channel](#).

We welcome your complete application, including your **CV** as well as **the title** and **an abstract (max 1 page)** of your proposal for presentation, to be submitted until **September 1, 2020** to **ukraine@europa-uni.de**
